CRITERIA

Criteria for grant of Financial Assistance to SC/ST students of the Teaching Departments w.e.f. the session 2020-2021 approved by the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to make new guidelines in its meeting held on 26.10.2017.

1. Annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources of the SC/ST students should be less than or equivalent to Rs. 3.00 lacs. (Approved in Syndicate). In case father/guardian is an employee, annual income certificate from employer be attached. In other cases, affidavit of income of father/guardian be attached. The students are also required to supply the following information/documents :
 - i. Detailed mark sheet (Division and marks obtained) of the previous examination.
 - ii. Whether receiving/applied for any other scholarship i.e. financial assistance, post Matric Scholarship from any other source, if so, give details.
 - iii. Receipt of the total fee paid by the student including examination fee in the respective year.
 - iv. Photo copy of Bank Account Number and copy of aadhaar Card linked with bank account in the name of the student.
2. All the applications must be routed through the Chairperson/ Coordinator/ Director of the concerned department.
3. Any candidates who either failed or could not clear 50 % of the papers in the previous examination as on date of application would be not eligible for this financial assistance.
4. Financial Assistance to be given for 9 months, as is being done in the case of Government Scholarships, directly into the bank account of student.
5. Rs. 2000/- be given as an incentive (one time) to those SC/ST students, who have secured 65% marks or more and Rs. 1500/- to those SC/ST students who secured 55% to 64.99 % marks in the previous examination.
